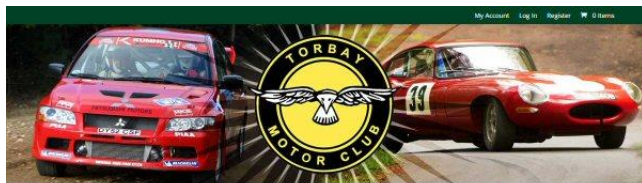

Dynamic new Torbay Motor Club website 'open for business'

Torbay Motor Club recently launched their new website – www.torbaymotorclub.co.uk – which features a host of new functions for motorsport enthusiasts, competitors, marshals and club members. The new site introduces numerous on-line entry systems that make it easy for competitors to store, and change at any time, all their entry and commentary information and then enter the club's events without having to re-submit the information for each subsequent event. New club members, marshals and media personnel can register on-line, well in advance of the 2015 season. The aim of these new functions is to save everyone time and duplicated effort, and to make the administration at events significantly more streamlined.

The site features a new level of interactivity with other media sources and has links to the club's

Torbay Motor Club Chairman, Dave Sims, commented: "This new website has been a big project for the club and its development is a significant step forward for us. Our aim is to provide a much better service for our members, encourage new enthusiasts to join the club and make it easy for volunteers to become involved in the sport. We're particularly pleased with the fresh and modern look that our website developers One Media at Woodbury Salterton have brought to the design; we are aiming to progressively expand the club's activities over time and the additional functions on the site will help us improve the way the club interacts with its members and the motorsport community in the South-West".

After a period of extensive testing and trialling, the new site's on-line entry systems have now gone 'live' with the publication of the regulations for the Torbay Trial, a round of the ASWMC Classic Reliability Trial championship, in March 2015. The entry systems for the club's other 2015 events – speed hillclimbs at Wiscombe Park and Manor Farm, a sprint at Clay Pigeon Raceway and Autosolos (the ideal low-cost entry point for newcomers to the sport) - will open as the regulations for each event are published.
