



## 'Tour of the Hills' – Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2019.

### Supplementary Regulations

1. **Torbay Motor Club** will organise a classic and sports car Touring Assembly on Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2019 in support of Budleigh Salterton & District Hospiscare.

The tour will start at the Warren Golf Club, Dawlish Warren and coincide with the first of the Club's Autumn 'Breakfast Club' meetings, where a range of breakfast meals and refreshments will be available to purchase if required. The finish will be at The Salty Monk, Sidford, nr Sidmouth, East Devon, where a 'Gentleman & Ladies' savoury and sweet high tea, included in the entry fee, will conclude the event. The route will comprise approximately 80 miles of smooth roads.

There will be no element of timing nor penalties for deviations from the suggested route.

2. The event will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any further written instructions issued by the organising club.
3. Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption number: TBA.
4. The event is open to Torbay Motor Club members and non-members. Applications for club membership are welcomed but is not a necessary entry requirement. A Competition Licence is not required.
5. The event is open to any car. Please notify any change of car from that originally entered as soon as the need to substitute is known, stating the replacement make, model and age.
6. All vehicles must meet the legal requirements to run on public roads in Great Britain. By entering the event you are confirming that you have valid insurance, MOT and road tax (as required), and that your vehicle is roadworthy. The use of trade plates is not permitted.
7. Timetable:  
*Signing on:* from 9:15 to 10.30 hrs at the start venue.  
*Start:* From 10.45 a.m., at one-minute intervals, in order of the entrants' choosing.  
*Finish:* From 3.30 p.m. approximately.
8. A Road book will be provided at signing-on containing both narrative and tulip diagram instructions, with total and intermediate distances in hundredths of a mile to enable entrants to follow the suggested Route.  
  
Help and guidance on using tulip diagrams will be available at signing-on.  
  
Not every junction will be shown or described in the Road book; in such instances, the correct route is to follow the current road.  
  
OS Landranger (1:50,000 scale) maps nos. 192 and 191 cover the route. All roads used will be covered by commercially available road atlases.
9. A traditional style Tour plate will be provided at signing-on and should be fixed in a forward-facing location on or in your vehicle. Please bring some string or cable ties.



10. Awards may be given at the discretion of the organisers.
11. Entries open on publication of these regulations and closes on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2019. You are encouraged to enter on-line at <https://www.torbaymotorclub.co.uk/events/>

Entries may also be made by downloading the official entry form from the website and submitting it by e-mail or post to the Entry Secretary.

Entries will be accepted when the entry fee is received.

*Entry Fees, to include the Road book, Tour plate and tea for two at The Salty Monk:*

Car, driver and passenger:	£55.
Car and unaccompanied driver:	£37.
Additional passengers:	£18 per head.

The minimum number of entries is 12 and the maximum 30. Should the minimum number not be received then the organisers have the right to cancel the event.

Entries will be acknowledged by email. Any Final Instructions will be e-mailed by Friday 20<sup>th</sup> September. In the event of cancellation, notification will also be sent by email. Please check your email regularly. If you do not have access to an email address, please include a stamped addressed envelope with your entry form.

12. If the event is postponed or cancelled, the organisers will refund any entry fees paid. If an entry is withdrawn in writing or email before the closing date, we will refund 100% of the entry fee. Entries withdrawn in writing or email between the closing date and Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> September will be refunded 50% of the entry fee (to cover committed expenses). No refund will be given for 'No shows' or cancellations on Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> September.
